Best Buddies in T.O.

Best Buddies International prez Anthony Shriver was in town to launch Best Buddies Canada, a non-profit organization he founded to provide disabled adults with supportive friendships from the mainstream community.

With parents Sargent and Eunice Kennedy Shriver in tow, Anthony — nephew of the late President John F. Kennedy, and better looking, if you can believe it — attended a private reception at the \$4 million Rosedale residence of builder Joe Brennan. There he met some of Best Buddies high-powered T.O. supporters, including Arij Gasiunasen, architect Eb and Jane Zeidler with daughter Kate, MDC boss Miles Nadal and wife Joanne; Dr. Sandy and Elizabeth Pritchard; Naomi Engel and daughter Amoryn, chair of the

junior Buddies committee; Sis Weld; lawyer Lezlie Oler and the extensive Greenglass clan.

Everyone was impressed by the suave and personable Sargent's storytelling abilities and Eunice's designer outfits (a Givenchy cocktail suit the first night; a silvery Armani pantsuit at Aqua the following evening) but were most enthralled by Anthony's wit and boyish, Kennedyesque, good looks.

After presenting the charter for Best Buddies Canada to gala co-chairs Penny Shore Hume and Danny Greenglass, and Buddies chair George Anderson, Anthony joked that his talkative dad was disappointed *he* wasn't getting to make the speeches.

"This is a great experience because I've had to do absolutely nothing to get here," Anthony quipped in praise of his T.O. hosts. Gosh, a dreamboat and modest, too. Can politics be far behind? But in politics, you learn to take credit for things you didn't do — that, or deny some you did.
